

You have the opportunity to make up select failed courses during Spring Credit Recovery. Courses include:

English 1	US History	IAG1	Geometry
English 2	American Government	IAG2	Algebra 2
English 3	Biology	IAG3	
English 4	Physical Earth Science	Algebra 1	

Your participation in the Credit Recovery Program is subject to departmental approval.

**English**: Students who failed the first semester of their English class for the current academic year with at least a 30% are eligible to participate in Credit Recovery.

**Math**: Students who failed the first semester of their math class for the current academic year are eligible to participate in Credit Recovery, but must pass their second semester of that class or an equivalent class in the Spring. If they do not, they will be enrolled in the same class in the fall.

**Social Studies**: To participate in credit recovery for US History or American Government, you must have earned at least a 30% in the failed semester.

**Science**: You may only participate in Biology or Physical Earth Science credit recovery if your semester average is at least 30%.

If you are successful at completing the tutoring and passing required exams (or essays), we will replace the F with a D (60%) for the failed semester of the course.

If you have any questions, see your subject teacher or your counselor.

## **Credit Recovery Guidelines:**

To get credit for one semester of English you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of Credit Recovery in English (50-59% semester average).
- Attend at least 30 hours of CR in English (30-49% semester average)
- Participate in lessons, reviews, and online programs on Language Arts topics
- Read an assigned book and pass an objective test over it.
- Satisfactorily write one essay and 2-4 journal assignments about the book that you read.

To get credit for one semester of IAG1, IAG2, IAG3, Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2 you must:

- Pass 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester of the Math course in the classroom.
- Attend at least 20 hours of the Credit Recovery in IAG, Algebra 1, Geometry, or Algebra 2.
- Complete 4 units of math content. Each unit consists of 4 assignments plus 1 review. Students must complete each assignment with a 100% before they can move on to the next assignment.
- All assignments, reviews, and unit tests must be completed in-person during designated Credit Recovery hours.
- Pass an exam at the end of each of the 4 units with at least a 60%.

To get credit for one semester of Government or US History you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of credit recovery (50-59% semester average)
- Attend up to 30 hours of credit recovery (30-49% semester average)
- Complete all assignments and pass a summative assessment by the end of the CR period in order to receive credit.
- Sign an attendance & work requirement agreement for the course.

To get credit for one semester of Biology you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of Credit Recovery in Biology
- Participate in lessons and activities on Biology topics through a Google Classroom platform
- Complete all tasks in each of the four assignments for each unit with a 60% or higher.
- Complete four assessments with a 60% or higher.

To get credit for one semester of Physical Earth Science you must:

- Attend at least 20 hours of Credit Recovery in Physical Earth Science
- Participate in lessons, assignments, and assessments on Physical Earth Science through a Google Classroom platform.
- Complete five labs and ten assignments with a 60% or higher.
- Complete three assessments with a 60% or higher.
