The program is centered on teaching and rewarding students for positive behavior performance. CCHS has four Terrier Traits that are expected in every area of the school. Those traits are: Be Here & Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Involved, and Be Responsible. The PBIS Committee has developed a behavior matrix that explains what behaviors are expected, in relation to those traits. The matrix is posted in every classroom and throughout the school. There are numerous incentives that students are rewarded for positive behavior. The PBIS committe meets monthly to disucss Tier 1 supports and a sub-group meets monthly on Tier 2/3 supports.
