**Services:**

Shawnee's School Health Center can see any student, faculty member, staff or their family members of the school district. We offer the same care that you can get at most primary care physician offices. This includes care for chronic illness; acute illness or minor injuries; school and sports physicals; immunizations; health education; disease prevention; and counseling services. The only service that the School Health Center will NOT provide is prenatal care. Patients requesting this service will be referred to their primary care provider or to a local community resource.

**Keeping your usual health care providers updated:**

Shawnee's School Health Center is here to help you whenever you need it! If you plan to come only when your health care provider is not available, we will send copies of our visit to them so they are up to date with your health care needs.

**Keeping parents or guardians updated:**

If you give us permission, we will contact you and then see your child without you coming to the health center. Please check the box below to tell us how to handle your child's visits:

- My child can only be seen at the School Health Center if **I am present**
- My child can be seen at the School Health Center if **I am not present.** I understand that I will be contacted by phone before any care is provided.

**Release for Students Information to the School District:**

We will not share any of your health information with school officials. However, you may find it convenient if you give us permission to give or exchange records with school officials so that a student's school required health records are updated. For example, students entering Kindergarten, 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 9<sup>th</sup> grade must have completed school physicals with updated immunization information before classes can be attended. Students involved in sports have to have a sports physical on file to participate in practices or games.

If you would like for the School Health Center to give or exchange information with the school, please complete the section below. You do not have to sign this release. If you do sign the release, the School Health Center will release information until the student leaves the school district or when you revoke, or withdraw your permission. *To withdraw your permission, you will need to send a request to HIPAA Officer, Shawnee Health Service 109 California Street PO Box 577 Carterville, IL 62918-0577.*
